Shovel 6 becomes local tourist attraction

Electric shovel (No.6) was taken out of operation early in 2010 and a decision was made to relocate the machine with the intention of it being used as a tourist attraction, relatively close to the mining operation.

The Collie Rotary Club volunteered to restore the original appearance of the shovel, cleaning, preparing and painting the machine. Local businesses have

assisted in the project, assisting with providing the paint, scaffolding and building an access road from the nearby highway.

Premier Coal supported the Collie Rotary Club with a payment for painting the shovel with the intention that the Club would then donate any proceeds to a worthy community organisation.
